OPEN POTTERY REQUIREMENTS

JANUARY 1, 2022

To participate in NHAC open pottery sessions:

1. Must have completed a 6 weeks general pottery class. Workshops and special pottery classes (such as Raku or extruder classes) do not count as the class requirement.
2. Must contact the pottery supervisor to schedule a studio review session. In this session, you will show the supervisor that you know how to use the pottery wheels, slab roller, wedging tables, tools, glazes, etc. You will be asked to explain the pottery making process and proper clean up procedures. Please bring a sample of your work. This will ensure that you have the skill level needed to work independently, to use the expensive equipment properly and have your piece fired as to not ruin other pottery or kiln shelves.
3. After this review, you will be able to sign up for Open Pottery Sessions or the supervisor will recommend that you take another general class to refine your skills.
