- Acrylic paints, studio or student quality, 2 oz OR 5 oz tubes in the following colors
- Alizarin crimson
- cadmium red medium
- cadmium orange
- cadmium yellow light
- yellow ocher
- ultramarine blue
- cobalt blue
- pthalo blue
- pthalo green
- hooker's green
- prism violet
- burnt sienna
- burnt umber
- raw umber
- mars black
- titanium white
- Painter's palette (wood, acrylic, or disposable pad)
- Selection of 8-10 brushes, both natural bristle and acrylic, in FLAT and ROUND. Ensure you have a variety of sizes between 2-16, including a flat brush between size 14-20 for broad strokes and underpainting.
- 9 " $\times 12^{\prime \prime}$ canvas pad (paper)
- 3-4 stretched canvases OR hardboard canvas panels, between 16 " $\times 20$ " and $20^{\prime \prime} \times 24$ " (feel free to go slightly larger if you prefer to work big)
- Palette knife
- 1-2 glass jars or large mugs with wide mouth
- Acrylic medium
