

Introduction to Acrylic Painting

Materials List:

- Acrylic paints, studio or student quality, 4 oz OR 8 oz tubes in the following colors –
 - o Alizarin crimson, cadmium red medium, cadmium yellow light, yellow ocher, ultramarine blue, cobalt blue, pthalo blue, pthalo green, hooker's green, prism violet, burnt sienna, burnt umber, raw umber, mars black, titanium white (white recommended in 8 oz tube if the rest are to be 4 oz)
- Painter's palette (wood or acrylic)
- Selection of brushes, both natural bristle and acrylic, in these FLAT and ROUND. Ensure you have a variety of sizes between 2-16, including a flat brush between size 14-20 for broad strokes and underpainting. Ideally, you will have 4-6 round brushes and 3-4 flat brushes.
- 9"x12" canvas pad
- 3-4 stretched canvases OR hardboard canvas panels, roughly 20"x24" (feel free to go slightly larger if you prefer to work big)
- Palette knife
- 1-2 glass jars or large mugs with wide mouth
- OPTIONAL: Acrylic medium
